*Multiples Fee: Additional \$10/hour for multiples (for Postpartum Support only; no multiples fee for Birth Support).

Sibling Doula Care: Receive in-home care for older siblings while you labor at home or travel to another birth location for your labor and birth. Benefit from extra hands and on-call support from doula at any time. Starting at \$300/6 hours

Nursery Organization: Envision your baby's nursery aesthetically designed and organized with safety and functionality in mind. Receive assistance with light furniture construction and furniture placement and supplies organization. Starting at \$250/4 hours

Virtual Doula: Receive warmth, comfort, and physical and emotional support virtually during your labor and birth. Doula will provide a virtual prenatal and postpartum visit and virtual labor support. Doula will give your family a labor support box before the onset of labor including: TENS unit, battery-operated candles, stress balls, tennis balls, knee pads, fan, lip-balm, comfort measures cards, intervention cards, affirmation cards.
